

# The Origins and Beginnings of the FEED School Education Project

## *Education As A Movement For Women's Empowerment*

It all began in the 90s when the founding members of FEED traversed vast demographics in the rural south Telangana to discover one common factor connecting people to backwardness and poverty - lack of education. Further analysis showed, at many places, there was a profound lack of educational facilities and for sustenance people were dependent on loans. The idea of FEED was born to counter this depressing scenario.

FEED was formed with the objective of eradicating illiteracy by making quality education accessible to one and all. The trust identified a number of villages and kick started the process of establishing educational institutes and adopting the existing ones. Some of the schools were just one room tenements manned by just one teacher. The spirit of giving was all pervading which powered the process of establishing schools in the designated places.

## *Adoption Of Schools*

139 schools were established in the remote villages of Medak and Rangareddy districts in the 1993 making it the water- shed period for FEED. Later with the introduction of Sarva Siksha Abhiyan (SSA) these schools were jointly managed by the Trust with the help of the Government. FEED pitched in by providing teachers, benches and uniforms.

The whole initiative proved out to be a great success as students of these schools performed better than in government schools, thanks to the efforts of dedicated teachers and our network of supervisors. As a welcome development, in a few remote areas, some of the schools were merged with the nearby ones to consolidate their strength. Presently, 100 schools supporting 23,200 deserving students, across Telangana and Andhra Pradesh are being supported by FEED.

## *Educate A Girl Child, Educate A Generation*

Fully committed to the empowerment of women, FEED adopts a holistic approach to the subject by providing quality education and imparting life skills. 70% of all students presently being educated at FEED schools are girls. The students are supported by free distribution of uniforms, dual desk benches, scholarships, food grain kits and a better environment to learn and thrive.

## Current Activities at a Glance:



### **Benches Project**

*25 Urdu medium schools have been provided with dual desk benches for students at an approximate cost of Rs. 19 Lakhs during the year 2021-22.*



### **Food Grains Distribution**

*Food grains are distributed annually to all the students studying in FEED supported schools at a cost of Rs. 1.30 Crores.*

### **Urdu Medium Schools**

Most of the Urdu medium schools run by the trust are located in the interior villages and far flung rural areas of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh states. These villages are very backward even today in terms of educational infrastructure and facilities. The only opportunity children enjoy of getting any meaningful education in those areas is through schools run, managed and supported by FEED.


The Trust not only facilitates access to education to these kids but also provides all other educational and humanitarian aid to its students as part of its broader educational awakening and social welfare initiative under FEED.

***“Currently, 23,200 students are being educated in 100 FEED supported Govt. Urdu medium schools on an annual expenditure of Rs.1.15 Crores, 70% of them are girls (this figure is apart from the other projects mentioned above). Every year, about 3,600 students, in 10th class, pass out with great results from these schools.”***
